- 3. The minimum equipment requirements for safe RVSM flight.
- 4. The reinforcement of cockpit drills to ensure that ATC clearances are fully understood, correctly complied with and queried should the need arise.
- 5. Information on the use and limitations of standby altimeters.
- 6. Visual perception differences at altitudes where previously a 2000 ft separation was applied.

- 11. The requirement for any aeroplane/operator combination to have been granted State approval for RVSM operations and that this approval may have to be in addition to any other approvals required for operation in given airspace.
